Who we are

The Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters (CCHI) is a 501(c)6 organization founded in 2009, whose mission is to develop and administer a comprehensive national certification program for healthcare interpreters, bringing together representatives from interpreting associations, language companies, community-based organizations, educational institutions, hospitals, health and healthcare providers, and advocates for patients with limited English proficiency.

What we stand for

CCHI Commissioners brought together stakeholders through a non-profit organization whose main mission is to develop and administer a national, valid, credible, vendor-neutral certification program for healthcare interpreters in the U.S.

CCHI offers two national certifications: the Core Certification Healthcare Interpreter™ (CoreCHI™) and language-specific, performance Certified Healthcare Interpreter™ (CHI™) certification in Arabic, Mandarin and Spanish.

- Over 3,370 nationally certified healthcare interpreters by the end of 2017: 2,643 CHI™-Spanish, 736 CoreCHI™, 127 CHI™-Mandarin, and 73 CHI™-Arabic certificants.

Certified Interpreters Community

- 1,098 healthcare interpreters completed an application for CCHI's certification program. 1,027 applications were approved.
- Top 12 states by the number of certified interpreters are CA, WI, MA, TX, OH, AZ, MN, IL, SC, MI, NY, OR.
- A total of 1,103 candidates for both CoreCHI[™] and CHI[™] certifications took the CoreCHI[™] exam. The CoreCHI[™] exam passing rate is 85.9%.
- 236 CoreCHI[™] candidates took the CoreCHI[™] exam in 2017, and 192 new CoreCHI[™] certifications were granted.
- 686 CHI[™]-Spanish candidates took the CHI[™]-Spanish exam in 2017, and 499 CHI[™]-Spanish certifications were granted. The CHI[™]-Spanish exam passing rate is 73.5%.
- 103 candidates took the CHI[™]-Arabic exam in 2017. The CHI[™]-Arabic exam passing rate is 11.7%. 12 CHI[™]-Arabic certifications were granted.
- 64 candidates took the CHI[™]-Mandarin exam. The CHI[™]-Mandarin exam passing rate is 46.9%. 30 CHI[™]-Mandarin certifications were granted.
- 223 certificants renewed their certification for the next four-year cycle. 473 certificants submitted their Year-2 renewal applications.
